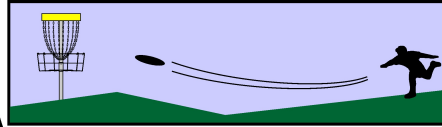

DIRECTIONS TO COURSES

Knob Hill Disc Golf Course: HQ at Overlook Pavilion

From the South: Exit 75 off I-79 north of Pittsburgh, left at stop, quick right on Brush Creek, 1 mile to left on Knob Rd., 1 mile to park, follow 2nd entrance road left to parking lot.

From the North: Exit 78 on I-79 S. at Cranberry. RIGHT on RT. 228 for .2 mile then LEFT on Rt. 19S. Go 1.2 miles to a RIGHT on Brush Creek Road. Follow Brush Creek Road as it turns LEFT at traffic light at Thorn Hill Industrial Park. Travel .5 mile then turn RIGHT at Knob Road. 1 mile to second Knob Hill Park entrance.

From East or West on PA Turnpike: Exit I-76 at Cranberry (Exit 28) and exit South on Rt. 19. Go 1 mile to RIGHT on Brush Creek Road. Follow Brush Creek Road as it turns LEFT at traffic light at Thorn Hill Industrial Park. Travel .5 mile then turn RIGHT at Knob Road. 1 mile to second Knob Hill Park entrance.

Two Mile Run Extension Disc Golf Course: 1250 Brighton Road, Brighton, PA

From North or West: I-76 to Exit 10 New Castle/Pittsburgh (.4 miles), then follow I-376 South (formerly PA Rt. 60) toward Beaver/Pittsburgh (9.5 miles). Take Exit 14 toward Brighton (.3 miles) then turn LEFT onto Brighton Road. In .4 miles, turn RIGHT into 1250 Brighton Road Maintenance Facility entrance. Follow road down hill past buildings to parking area.

From East or South: I-376 North (formerly PA Rt. 60) to Exit 14 toward Brighton, then turn RIGHT onto Brighton Road. In .4 miles, turn RIGHT into 1250 Brighton Road Maintenance Facility entrance. Follow road down hill past buildings to parking area.

Schenley Park Disc Golf Course: HQ in Camp David Lawrence Pavilion near Hole 7.

From East-- Bates St. exit 3B off I-376, Merge onto Bates street, then Right on Blvd. of the Allies (traffic light) east towards Squirrel Hill (through three traffic lights), over Anderson Bridge then Right on Overlook Dr. 1st tee at top of hill near skating rink.

From West – I-376 Oakland/Forbes Avenue Exit 2A. Keep Right for Blvd. of the Allies ramp – bear Right onto Ophelia Street, then first Left onto Hamlet Street, then quick right onto Blvd of Allies. Straight through three traffic lights, over Anderson Bridge then Right on Overlook Dr. 1st tee at top of hill near skating rink. **From North –** I-279S Veterans Bridge. Stay in Right lane and exit for Oakland. Stay on Boulevard of Allies through 3 traffic lights east towards Squirrel Hill, over Anderson Bridge then Right on Overlook Dr. 1st tee at top of hill near skating rink.

Moraine State Park:

From Pittsburgh and South; take I-79 north to Portersville exit 96. RIGHT at stop sign, 1.2 miles on S.R. 488, then LEFT onto Pleasant Valley Rd. .8 miles to LEFT onto US 422 West. 2.3 miles to RIGHT toward North Shore. .3 miles and RIGHT at stop sign. Follow N. Shore Drive 3.1 miles, then RIGHT to Lakeview Beach, LEFT into parking lot.

Deer Lakes Park: HQ in Blue Gill Pavilion

CAUTION: CONSTRUCTION ON Rt. 28 N of Pittsburgh REQUIRES ADVANCE PLANNING AND EXTRA TIME!

From Pittsburgh: take Rt. 28 N. Exit 12 at Cheswick/Springdale. Right at stop sign at exit ramp, then .4 miles make right toward Russellton on Little Deer Creek Road. 2.5 miles through one lane tunnel. 2 miles make right on Orange Belt in Russellton (Between bank and Palmer Drug). Go under train overpass .1 mile and make immediate left into Deer Lakes Park Main entrance. Follow road .5 miles, then turn right into Entrance #1. Park in upper end of Blue Gill parking lot.

From the North Hills: follow Orange Belt. Rt. 910 east, left on Oak Road and follow Orange Belt into Russellton. Turn left into Deer Lakes Park Main entrance. Follow road .5 miles, then turn right into Entrance #1. Park in upper end of Blue Gill parking lot

POINTS CALCULATION FOR INDIVIDUAL AND SCHOOL COMPETITIONS

DIVISIONS: HS Boys (grades 9-12), HS Girls (grades 9-12), MS Boys (grades 1-8), MS Girls (grades 1-8)

BASE POINTS: The winner of a division earns a base of 100 points. Base points for lower places are subtracted from 100 in intervals.

The interval for 2nd and 3rd place is 5; base points for 2nd is $100-5 = 95$ and 3rd is $100-10 = 90$.

The interval for 4th - 8th place is 4; base points for 4th is $100-14(5+5+4) = 86$.

The interval for 9th - 14th place is 3.

The interval for 15th - 25th place is 2.

The interval for 26th place and lower is 1.

TOTAL POINTS: A player's total = her base points + 1 point for each of the players s/he finished ahead of or tied and a point for herself.

For example, the player with the lowest cumulative score in a division of 20 player gets 120 points ($100 + 20$); 4th gets 103 ($86+17$), 20th gets 41 ($40+1$).

Players with tied scores receive the same number of points. The players below the tie receive the points for the place 2 (or more) spots below the tied place.

Players who do not finish the tournament will earn only 1 point for themselves.

TEAM RESULTS: Total points earned by all players from the same school district (HS Boys, HS Girls, MS Boys, MS Girls) are added together from all the events in the series.

INDIVIDUAL RESULTS: Three (3) events are needed to qualify for Individual Series Awards. Players who have more than three events can use their best three results. The first tie-breaker will be the fourth event finish. Second tie-breaker will be the fifth event finish. Third tie-breaker will be total stroke difference in head to head competition over the entire series.
